Who are the Sustainers?

Sustainers evaluate themselves in light of their need for security, safety, and the harmony and stability of society, relationships, and of self. Driven towards survival and self-preservation, Sustainers tend to be inner-directed in their search for protection from misfortune and attack. A high percentage of Sustainers are in the retirement years and a significant number are women. Because of their lower income they are mainly focused on immediate needs, finding bargains, and making their fixed income dollars stretch. Uncomfortable with luxury, most Sustainers own homes that are modestly furnished with the basic necessities. They value the time-honored established traditions, and cherish memories and keepsakes of the past. Concerned about safety and security, they feel powerless and fearful in their own neighborhoods. They are resistant to change, and are not risk-takers.
