Dream Weavers

(72% Unreached)

Dream Weavers is home to well-off families living an affluent, suburban version of the American Dream. Ranked second in terms of wealth, they live in new-money subdivisions, possess high incomes, have college degrees and own large houses valued at more than twice the national average. Many households contain families with school-aged children-no segment has a higher rate of married residents-and more than half contain dual-income couples.

Solid Suburban Life

(77% Unreached)

Solid Suburban Life is a world of flagstone patios and redwood decks. Home to a mix of younger and middle-aged couples and singles, this Mosaic features primarily white and Asian households enjoying upscale comfort in their maturing bedroom suburbs. With almost equal numbers of high school and college graduates, the adults earn upper-middle-class salaries from lucrative careers in retail, finance, health care and information services.
