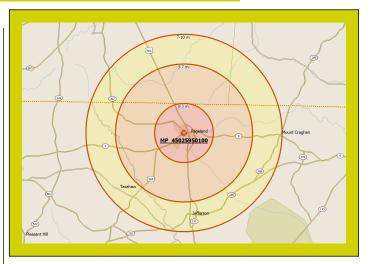

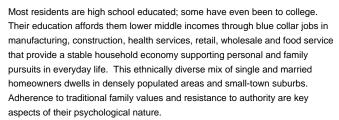

One in five adults are under 35 years old and the median household income is only half the national average.
