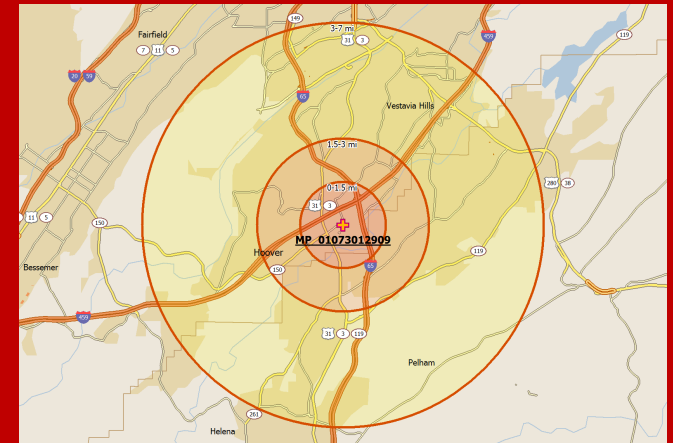

### Working Communities

Most residents are high school educated; some have even been to college. (72% Unreached)

Stable Careers is a collection of young and ethnically diverse singles living in big-city metros as Los Angeles, CA, Philadelphia, PA and Miami, FL. A quarter of the households are of Hispanic and Asian and are slightly less affluent than others dominated by Generation Y residents. More than half of households have gone to college and most have landed white-collar jobs in retail, health services and professional offices.

### Urban Commuter Families

Not all families have fled the nation's cities for the far-out suburbs. Young Cosmopolitans is a collection of households where many adults are under 35 years old, single and earning above average incomes as white-collar professionals, managers and executives. Nearly half hold college degrees, and they are almost twice the average for grad degrees.
