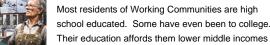

Working Communities

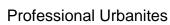
Urban Commuter Families

Small-town Success

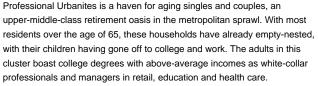
