Minority Metro Communities (74% Unreached)

Concentrated in inner-ring suburbs, these households earn above-average incomes from a mix of service industry and white-collar jobs.

One in five adults are under 35 years old and the median household income is only half the national average.

Family Convenience is a collection of sprawling families living in remote towns and military bases. Coal and Crops comes by its name honestly. The households of this rural cluster work primarily in the mining and farming industries. More than one-quarter of the residents never completed high school, the median household incomes are nearly 40 percent below the U.S. average.
